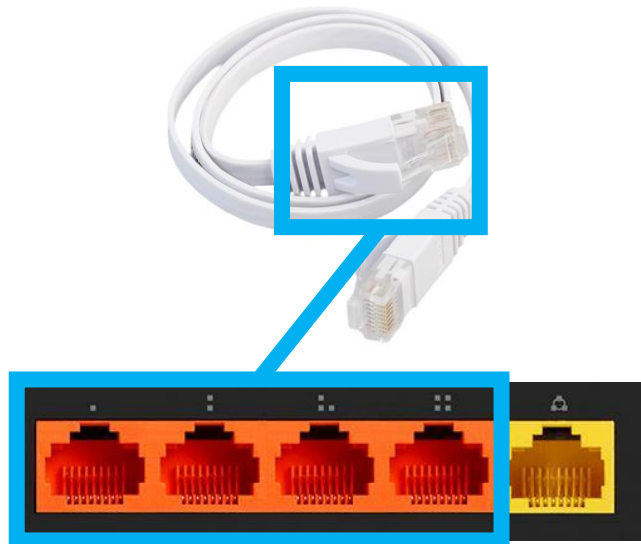
# STEP 1

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU WILL NEED A SECOND ETHERNET / LAN CABLE  
VERY IMPORTANT: DO NOT REMOVE LAN CABLE CONNECTED BETWEEN YOUR ROUTER'S WAN PORT AND THE ONU

## Connect your router to your computer

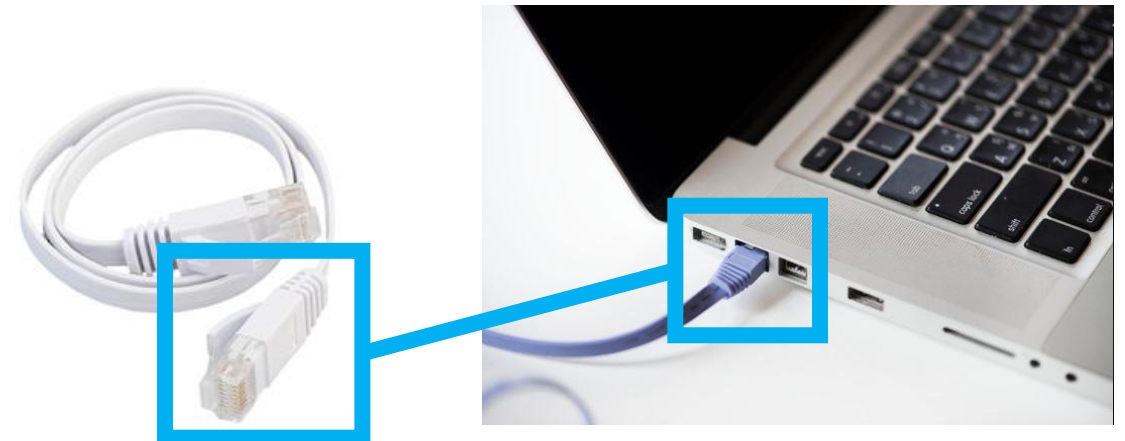
### STEP 1.1

Insert the one end of the LAN cable into one of the LAN ports on the back of the router

Insert the other end of the LAN cable into the LAN port on your computer



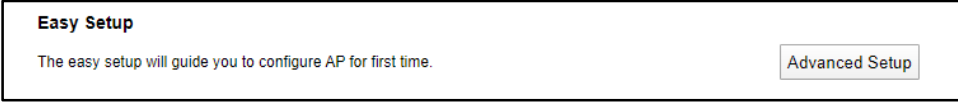

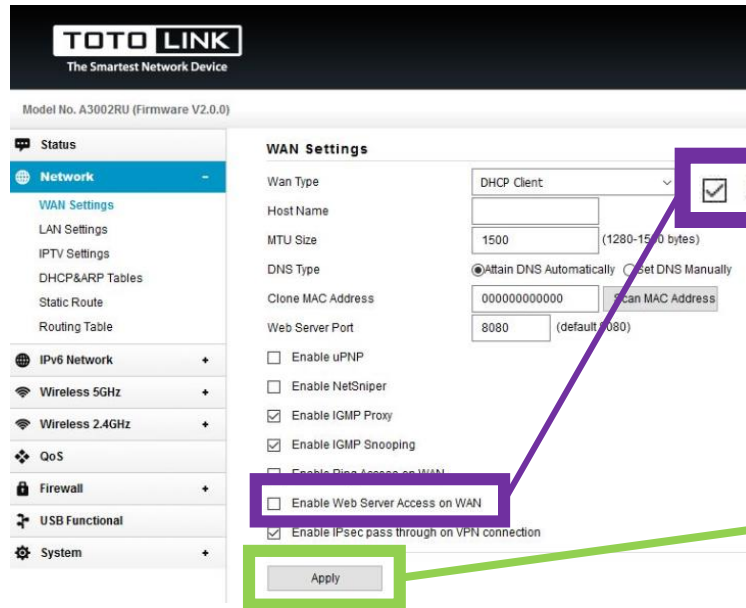
## STEP 4.1

Click the box “Enable Web Server Access on WAN”

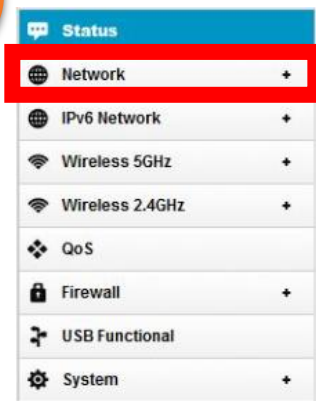


